

WE'VE BEEN CHANGING THE WORLD

Soul Bilíngue is an organization that democratizes international experiences to low-income students. Soul promotes immersion of the English language with international connections with Brazilians abroad and English native speakers, as well as psychological care and English scholarships outside Brazil to students who stand out in the program. The action has already qualified more than 500 students and led 13 low-income students to the dream of the exchange in countries like Australia, Canada, South Africa and England, with the collaboration of partners such as travel agencies and international English schools. The NGO was founded in 2018 by Ariane Noronha, aged 27, after having her life transformed by an au pair program in the United States. Daughter of a manicure and a warehouse assistant, Ariane has a degree in Journalism and lived abroad for 1 year and a half.




MENTAL HEALTH




